



City of Denton Boards & Commissions Special Qualifications

ANIMAL SHELTER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Committee is made up of the following:

- licensed veterinarian who has a principal place of business or a residence in the city of Denton¹
- city official²
- person who is employed by City of Denton Animal Shelter – does not have to live in City limits³
- representative of an animal welfare organization⁴
- three people who are not involved by occupation or membership in any of the above categories⁵

BOARD OF ETHICS

Preference is given to the following:

- attorneys¹
- architects²
- engineers³
- doctors⁴
- teachers⁵
- pastors⁶
- mediators⁷
- retired jurists⁸
- licensed professional counselors⁹
- those with licenses demonstrating high levels of education or master craftsmanship in the building trades¹⁰

*At least 3 members must be attorneys or retired jurists.

COMMITTEE ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Committee is made up of the following:

- members appointed by/for Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4 must reside in that district
- members appointed by/for the Mayoral, Place 5, and Place 6 Districts, may reside in any district of the city

HEALTH & BUILDING STANDARDS COMMISSION

Commission is made up of the following:

- general contractor¹
- representative from electrical industry²
- architect or engineer³
- two persons associated with construction, development or real estate⁴
- representative from plumbing industry⁵
- other⁶

HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION

Commission is made up of the following:

- a member of the Denton County Historical Commission¹
- a member of the Denton County Bar Association²
- an owner of real property³
- an architect⁴
- a CPA⁵
- other member - provided that no one (1) business or professional interest shall constitute a majority membership of the commission⁶
