

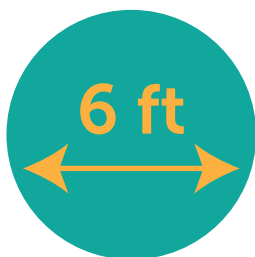
PROTECT EMPLOYEES & CUSTOMERS

COVID-19 is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person through close contact (less than 6 ft of space), and through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks.



Clean your hands often.

Wash your hands. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.



Avoid close contact.

Encourage social distancing of 6 feet or more with signs and markings in areas where lines form. Only open every other checkout register lane (including self-checkouts) to increase distancing. If possible, provide curbside service to minimize foot traffic inside your business.



Use a cloth face cover and gloves at work.

Employers should provide personal protective equipment, including masks and gloves to all employees who will come into close contact with other people or who touch common surfaces. Unless you work in a medical facility, do **NOT** use a face mask meant for a healthcare worker.



Cover coughs and sneezes.

If you do not have a mask, always cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, or use the inside of your elbow. Throw used tissues in the trash and immediately wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds.



Clean and disinfect.

Clean **AND** disinfect high traffic areas and self-checkout stations frequently. Keep a logbook of how often areas are cleaned and disinfected.



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
