

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-044

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS OF THE BOND ELECTION HELD ON FEBRUARY 5, 2005; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

COUNTY OF DENTON
CITY OF DENTON

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Denton, Texas ("City") ordered an election to be held in the City on February 5, 2005 for the approval or disapproval of general obligation bonds on the PROPOSITIONS hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to this election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of this election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held the election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and these returns have been duly delivered to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this election has been canvassed in accordance with Section 67.003 of the Election Code and all other applicable laws at a time not earlier than the eighth day or later than the 11th day after election day; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by the Texas Government Code, Chapter 551; NOW, THEREFORE;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The findings set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are incorporated by reference into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. That the City Council officially finds and determines that the election held on February 5, 2005 was duly ordered, that proper notice of this election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to this election, that this election was duly held, that the returns of the result of this election have been made and delivered to the Council, and that the City Council has duly canvassed these returns, all in accordance with the law and the ordinance calling this election.

SECTION 3. That the official returns of the election officials having been opened, examined, and canvassed and the City Council officially finds and determines that 2,220 votes were cast at this election on the submitted PROPOSITIONS by the resident, qualified electors of the City, who voted at the election and that the votes cast for each proposition on the ballot for the bond election were as follows:

SECTION 5. That the aforesaid bonds may be issued, as voted and as provided by law.

SECTION 6. That the City Council has found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is considered is open to the public and that notice thereof was given in accordance with provisions of the Texas open meetings law, Tex. Gov't Code ch. 551, as amended, and that a quorum of the City Council was present.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
