

ORDINANCE NO. 22-773

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO ELECT THREE CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS TO PLACES 5, 6, AND A MAYOR TO PLACE 7 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON, HELD ON MAY 7, 2022; DECLARING THAT A RUNOFF ELECTION IS NOT NECESSARY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS a regular municipal election of the City of Denton was held on May 7, 2022, to elect Council Members to Places 5, 6 and a Mayor to Place 7; and

WHEREAS, the official returns of the election have been opened, examined and canvassed; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds and declares that the May 7, 2022 regular municipal election was duly ordered for the purpose of electing council members to Places 5 and 6 and a Mayor to Place 7; proper notice of said election was duly given and election officials appointed; the election was duly held and the returns of the election officials have been delivered to the Council, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Denton.

SECTION 2. The official returns of the election, herein incorporated by reference and attached as "Exhibit A", having been opened, examined, and canvassed, and the Council hereby finds and declares the following candidates received a majority of the votes cast at the election in Place 5, 6, and 7 and are declared to be elected to the City Council of the City of Denton as follows:

FOR PLACE 5:	Brandon Chase McGee
FOR PLACE 6:	Chris Watts
FOR PLACE 7 (Mayor):	Gerard Hudspeth

and the candidates shall assume the duties of office on the date they take the official oath of office.

SECTION 3. The City Council finds and declares all candidates received a majority of the votes cast and runoff election is not necessary.

SECTION 4. The City Council has found and determined the meeting at which this ordinance is considered is open to the public and that notice thereof was given in accordance with provisions of the Texas open meetings law, Texas Government Code Chapter 551, as amended, and that a quorum of the City Council was present.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

The motion to approve this ordinance was made by Paul Meltzer and seconded by Jesse Davis; the ordinance was passed and approved by the following vote [7 - 0]:
